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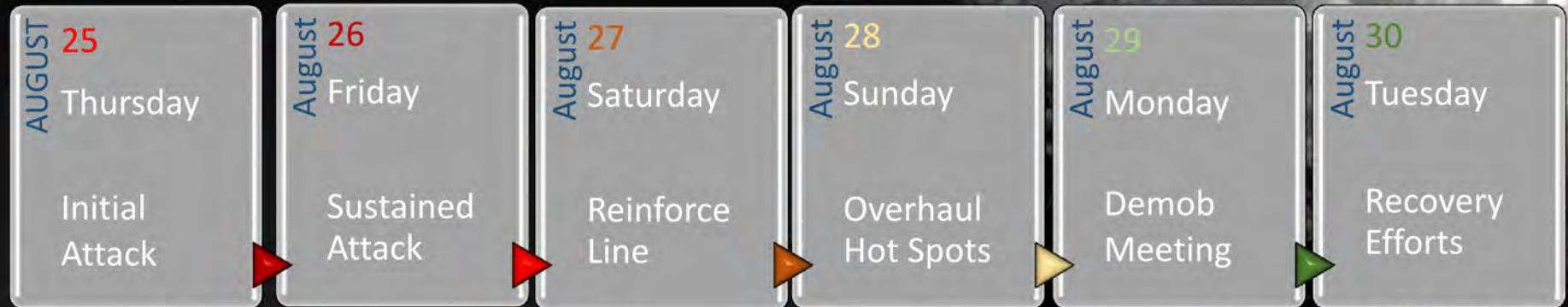
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Little Cranberry Fire August 2016

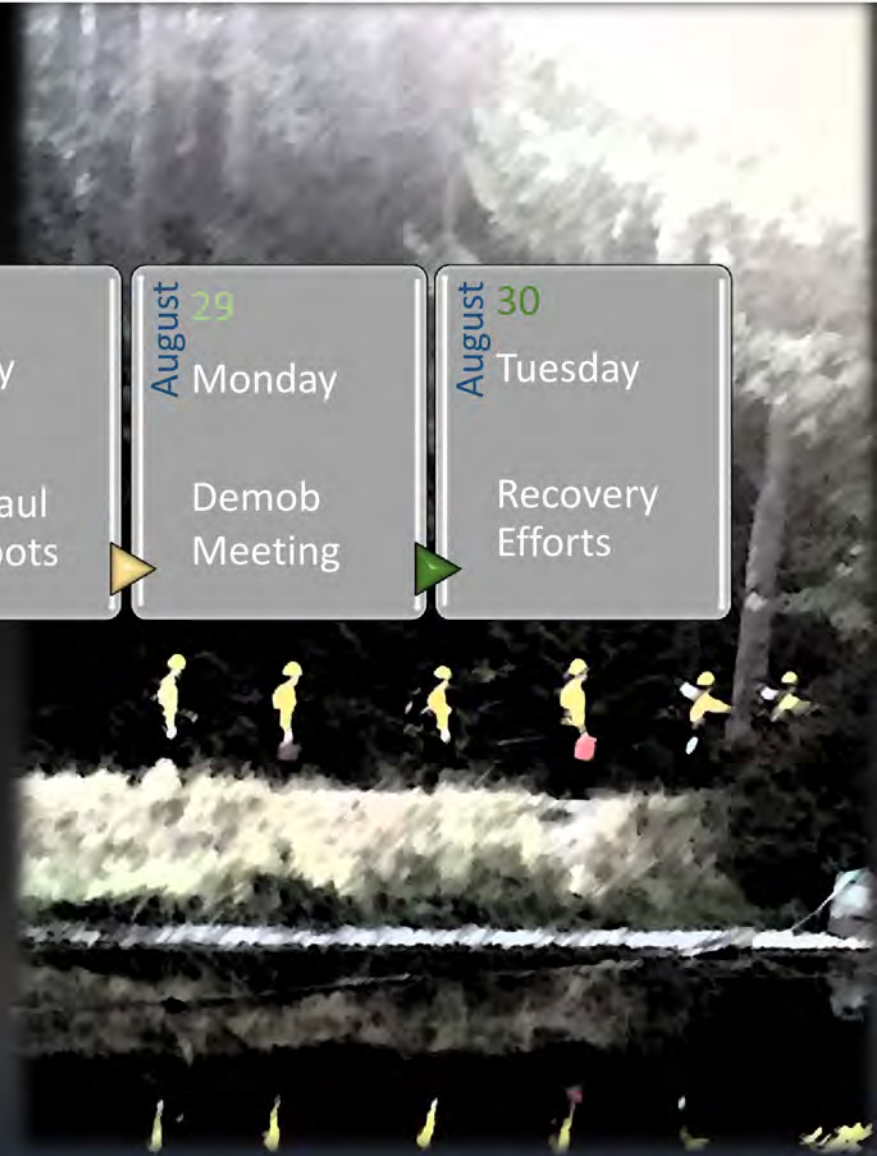

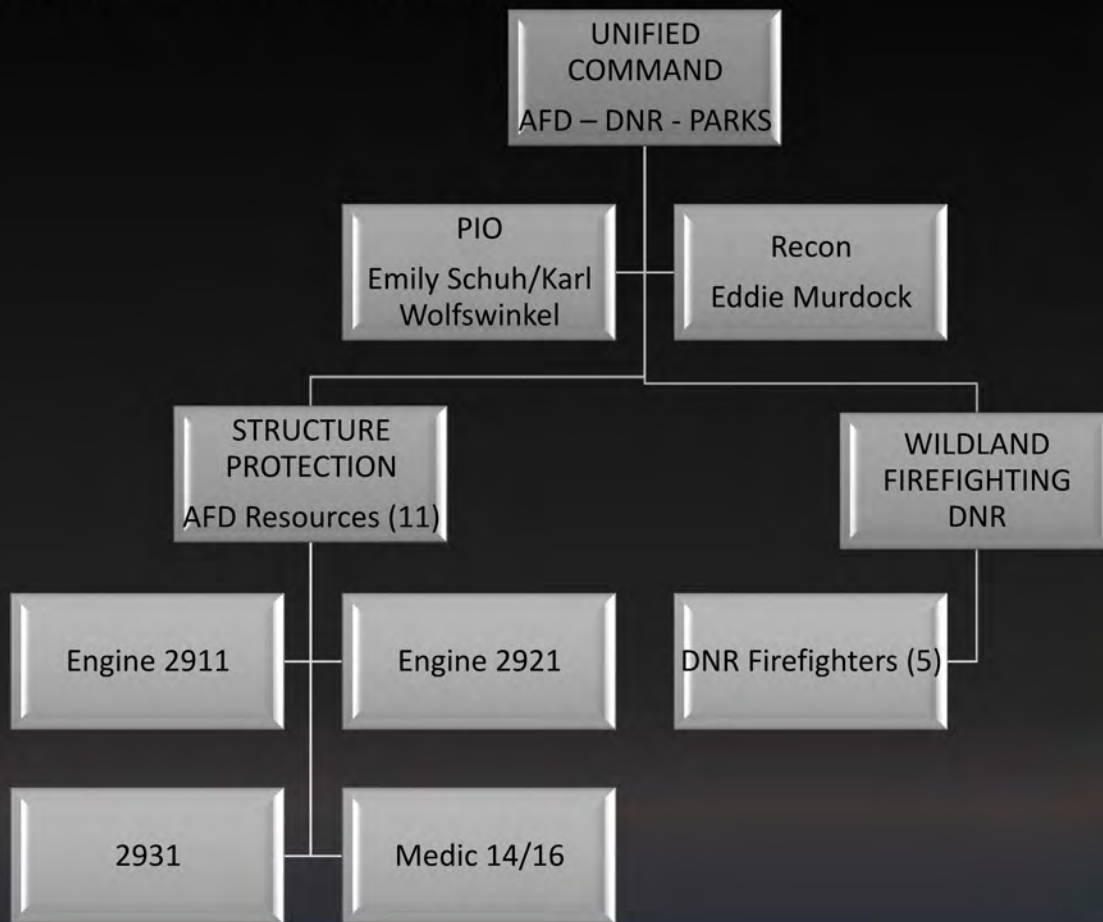

Friday Afternoon Organization



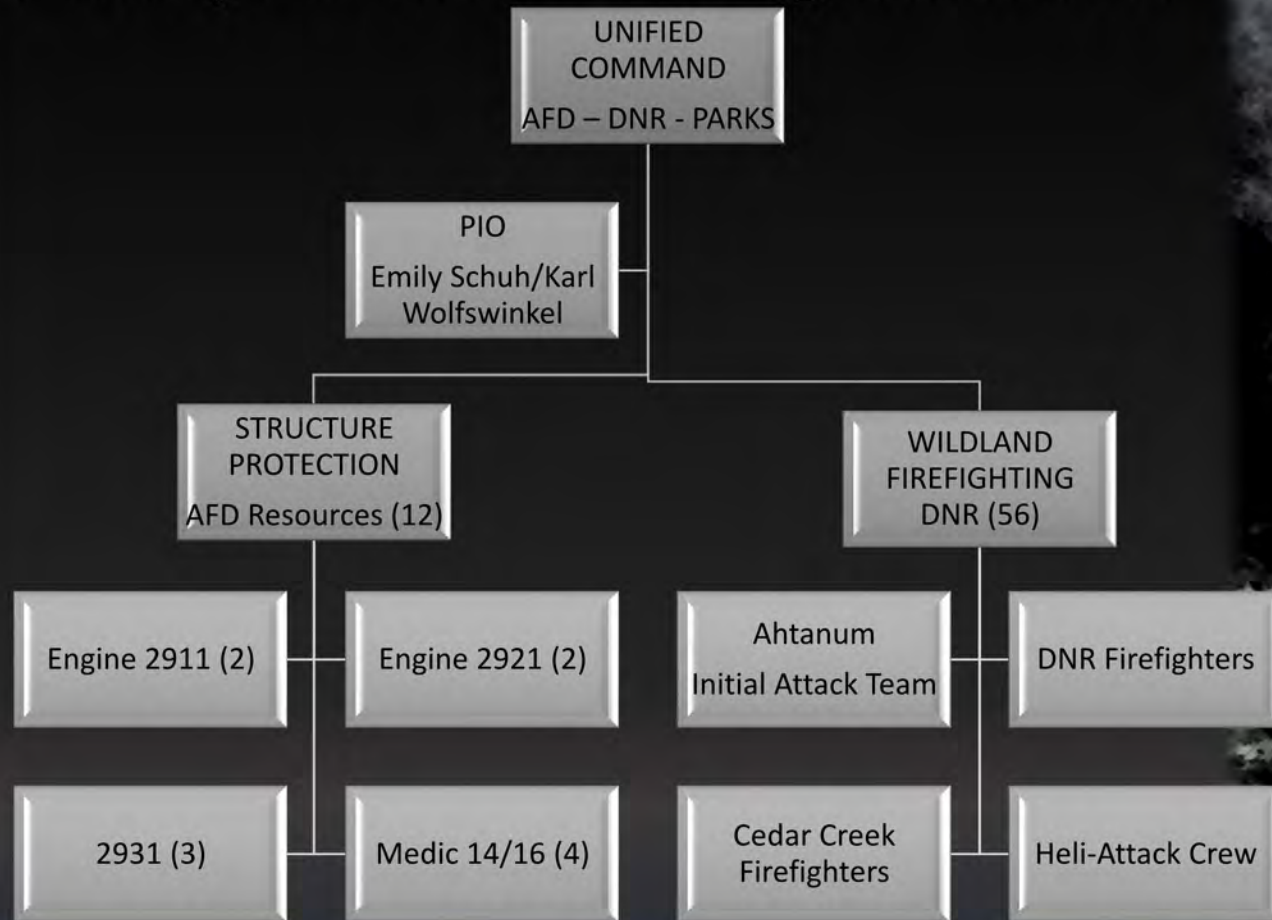
Friday Afternoon, August 26th (10-12 Acres)

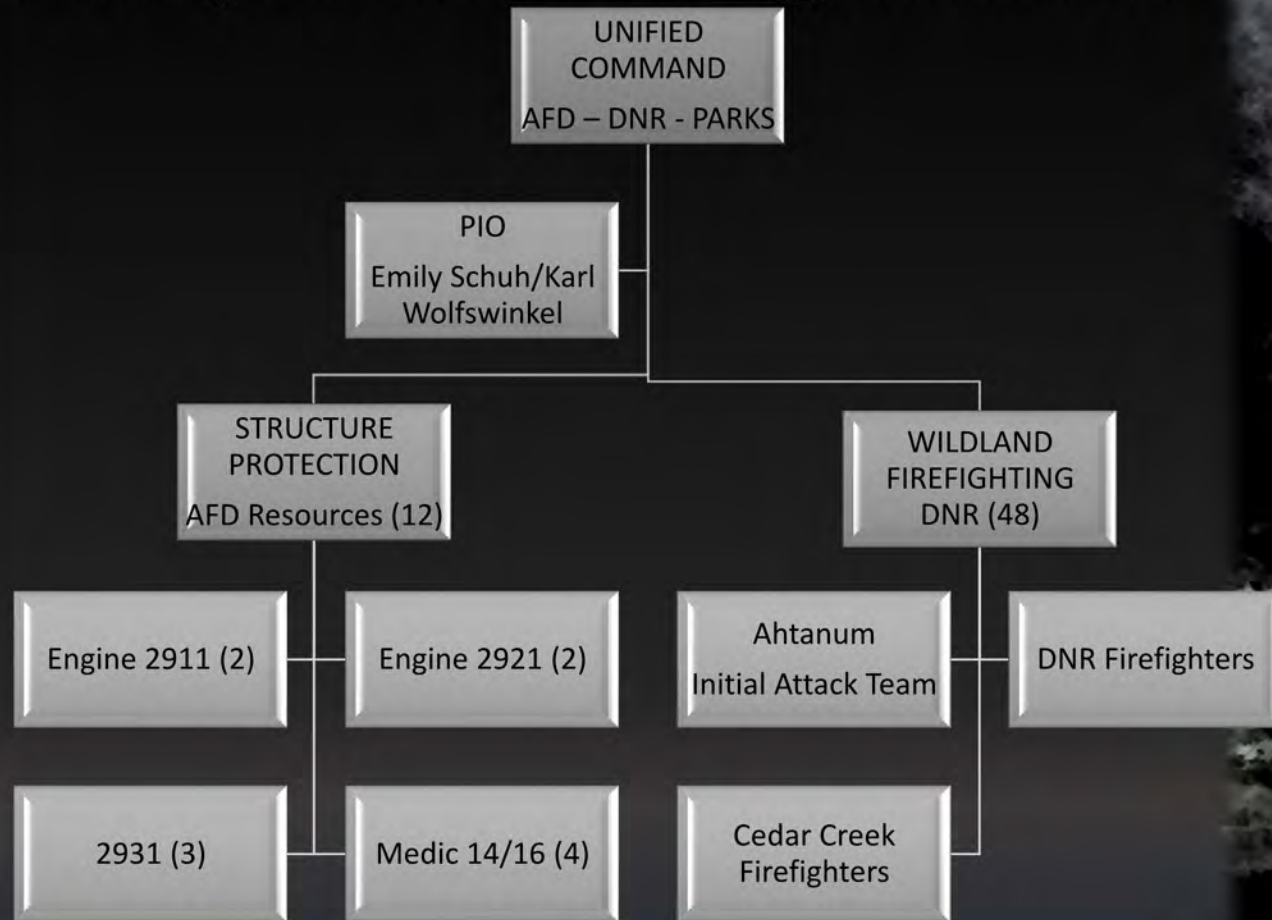

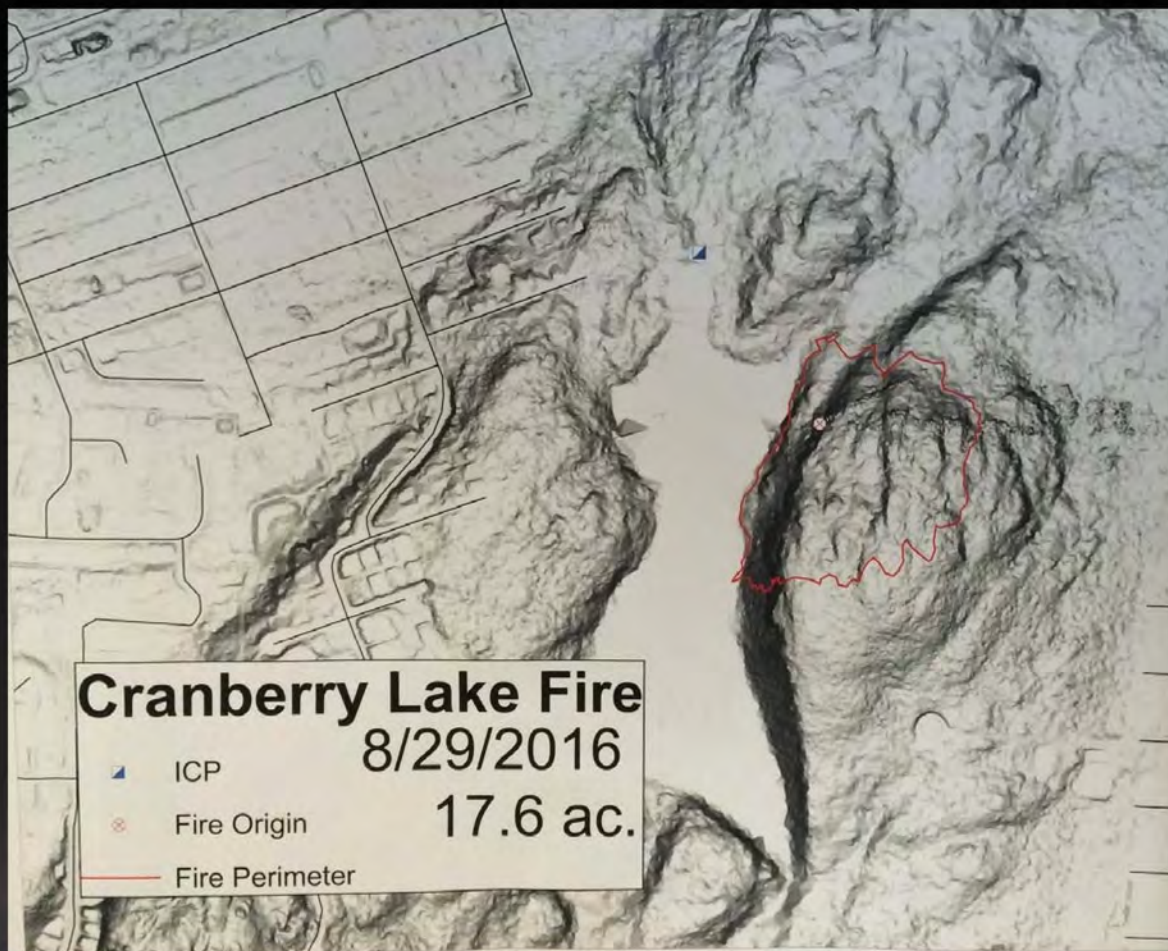

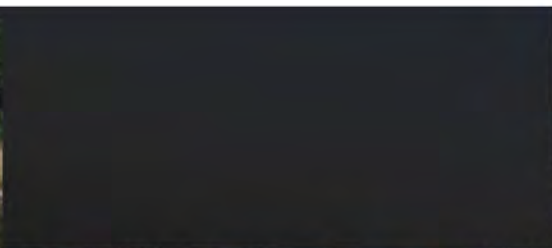




CURRENT STATUS
