

## **Anacortes City Council Minutes - April 18, 2022**

### **Call to Order Special Joint Meeting with the Port of Anacortes Commission**

Mayor Matt Miller called to order the advertised special joint meeting of the Anacortes City Council and the Port of Anacortes Commission at 6:00 p.m. Councilmembers Jeremy Carter, Ryan Walters, Anthony Young, Christine Cleland-McGrath, Carolyn Moulton, Bruce McDougall and Amanda Hubik were present.

Port of Anacortes Commission Chair Bonnie Bowers called the meeting to order for the Port.

### **Resolution 3081: Maritime Strategic Plan 2022**

Planning Director Don Measamer presented Resolution 3081 which would adopt a revised 2022 version of the Anacortes Maritime Strategic Plan jointly prepared by the City of Anacortes, the Port of Anacortes, the Anacortes Chamber of Commerce and the Economic Development Alliance of Skagit County. Mr. Measamer reviewed the plan and its collaborative development. Commissioners and councilmembers commented favorably on the plan and made suggestions for future revisions.
