Arts Foundation MOA:

Laura, Terry and Todd voiced approval at the last meeting for the MOA as written. Zack has no concerns. It will be sent out to the new members and will be revisited next month.

98221 Gallery Next Show:

Written report from Terry: The next 98221 Gallery show submissions closed yesterday, although I'm still waiting for a couple who said they were submitting, but I haven't seen. I will call them tomorrow. The jury will be next week. We will plan to hang the new show on May 31st. Artists for the current show will pick up artwork May 23 - 26. Drop off for the next show will be that week as well. We will plan to be a part of the June First Friday Art Walk June 3. More info will be forthcoming on that, but please mark your calendars and plan to attend if possible.

Art in Public Areas:

The idea was proposed by Todd and in his absence, Zack spoke to the general idea. The goal would be to combine education and arts in the smaller easements and artificial wetlands, those required by the City to be installed by the builder as part of a new development. The topic will be revisited next month.

Public Art & Brochure:

Laura and Lisa have been working on the brochure of public art on the island. There are 59 pieces listed with information about each piece. They are working on getting photos of each piece. There will be several driving loops as well as a walking loop. The final goal will be to put a brochure together and make it available to the public. The brochure would also have a link to the collection at the library. There may be funds available through LTAC and Arts Festival.

AMPfest:

Clarity spoke about this event. It will be held on September 10th from noon to 10pm at Seafarers Park. The idea presented would be to integrate art and music. Some options discussed were to exhibit outdoor art, working artists or other art in progress.

Other Business:

Zack relayed that the Procession of the Species is planning to participate in the 4th of July parade and will be holding several workshops in preparation. Support is needed, but the financial part has not been defined yet. The request made to the Arts Commission is to use the logo to show support for the group. The Board voted to allow the use of the logo.
