Commission Chair MacKenzie called the Public Hearing of April 6, 2022, to order at 6 pm.

New Business: CUP-2022-0001 Fiddlehead School Expansion

Emily Morgan, Senior Planner, gave a presentation on the proposed Fiddlehead School expansion, providing criteria of a Conditional Use Permit and the zoning code. Morgan also mentioned the city did not receive any public comments concerning the proposal and no concerns had been presented. Morgan continued with Staff recommended conditions of approval. Commissioners discussed the proposal and asked questions about the project. Kelly Linnemann and Jodi Boyden, representatives of the project, were on hand via Zoom and answered questions along with Staff.

Chair MacKenzie opened the floor for public comment at 6:36pm, but no public were present. The floor was closed for public comment at 6:37pm. Commissioner Molyneaux made a motion to "Approve CUP-2022-0001 subject to Staff recommended conditions of approval contained within the Staff report WITHOUT condition # 5".
