Madrona Grove:

The possibility of a call to artists in November with a deadline for submissions after the New Year. It was also discussed to increase the stipend and length of the show.

Public Art Map:

Other Business:

Jonn gave the update that City leadership does not want to see this art on City property. The Arts Festival is reevaluating their options.

Jonn also spoke about the new roundabout on R Ave and the possibility of art being placed there. Engineering will need to provide the specifics for this project.

It was asked if the new MJB project has any requirements for art. Jonn responded that there is nothing set yet but the museum would also like to see this area have more art.

A question was raised about the open seat on the Arts Commission and if it would be possible to have a member of the Samish Nation. Lisa is going to draft a letter and bring it for approval by the Board before sending to the Samish Commissioners.
