Anacortes Procession of the Species & Luminary Parade: Guests included Lolinda Bird, Peggy Flynn, Andy Stewert and Don Bird. The plan is to have an event on Earth Day (April 20th) that includes an afternoon procession of the species parade on from the Depot, up Sixth Street, and in a circle on Commercial and back to the Depot.
