Minutes: July minutes were unanimously approved.

Public Comments: Pat Gardner was in attendance to speak about Open Streets and dogs in attendance at the event. She is hoping that this could be an opportunity to teach community members about interacting with dogs when approached by a pedestrian or bicyclists.

Open Streets/Bike Pedestals: Kami and Betty have been working to organize the Arts Commission contribution to Open Streets. They will have a booth with maps of the bike racks in town. 3-6 of them will be decorated prior to the event by professional artists. Three others will be posted with a theme for kids to decorate during the event. Adult volunteers are needed for 2 hour shifts between 11 and 3. The kids will get stamps on their map and can earn a prize. The goal of this is to help highlight where the bike racks are in town.

Library Bike Pedestal: Betty and Trish are working on this project at the library. They are hoping to get this completed prior to school starting in September. They are asking for any adults that are wanting to join this project. Paint types have been recommended by Ace, with primer being the most important.

98221 Gallery: Bob gave a big thank you to Betty and Stephen for helping to hang the show. There has been one piece sold already. The next show will be up in time for the December art walk.

Other Business: Bob shared that Piano-cortes has been a big success. This project has now been turned over to the Arts Festival. A big thanks to How it Works for the sign and advertising for North Sound Piano.

Trish shared that the library has held a contest over the summer for new library card designs. She asked for help from the Commission to jury the submissions.

Zach gave an update on the Madrona grove, with the last piece being installed this week or next. Then the signs that are complete can be installed.
