Other Business:

Bob shared that North Sound Piano may be interested in helping with Piano-cortes. They would secure the pianos, move them and tune them. It was decided to open the artist pool to all of Skagit Valley. Bob will check with the Arts Festival about a stipend for the artists. Discussion was had about only doing two pianos so both are displayed under cover. Discussion was had about the Voice & Verse grant. The next step will be to attend the Manieri Foundation meeting. Proposal also being shared with the Arts Festival and the Downtown Anacortes Alliance.
